The welcome was given by Cheryl Cannon.

Motion was made by Bill Robinson and seconded by Mary Welch to approve last meetings' minutes. Motion passed.

New Business

1. Cheryl Cannon gave an update on the Fitness Subcommittee Meeting that will be held on April 15, 2016. One representative from each campus will attend.

2. Cheryl Cannon also gave a short explanation of the Safe Schools training that employees across the district are required to complete. The district has been using this software for 2 years and it is for school staff only. The Emergency Management module is assigned to the security members in the district, the Environmental portion is assigned to the maintenance department and all science teachers are required to complete the science lab safety module. The Health portion is assigned to various members throughout the district. The Nutrition Dept. and one person on each campus are trained on the Automated External Defibrillators (AED), all employees are required to complete the Bloodborne Pathogens and Health Emergencies, and all coaches must complete Concussion Awareness and Steroid & PED Awareness. Central Office staff must complete many of the modules in the Human Resources training and all employees are required to complete Sexual Harassment training. All Technology staff are required to complete the Information Technology module which includes Cyberbullying and Online Safety. The Nutrition Services modules are completed by the Nutrition Department and the Security Modules are completed by the Security Department. The Social & Behavioral portion of Safe Schools includes Bullying: Recognition & Response, Child Abuse: Mandatory Reporting, Human Trafficking Awareness and Youth Suicide: Awareness & Prevention which must be completed by all district personnel. Dating violence is completed by personnel beginning with 5th grade. The Special Ed Department must complete the Special Education modules and the Transportation Department must complete the Transportation modules.

Old Business

1. The Alanon/Alateen program that was presented at the January 25, 2016 was approved as well as the Local Wellness Policy.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Katelijne Acker and seconded by Linda Barganski. The motion passed.
