Flour Bluff ISD Board of Trustees name Dr. David Freeman Superintendent of Schools

Flour Bluff Independent School District Board of Trustees officially voted today during the May Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees to name Dr. David Freeman as the District's next Superintendent of Schools.

Dr. Freeman's contract is a three-year contract beginning July 1, 2019. The contract includes a \$185,000 salary package.

"Flour Bluff ISD is rich in tradition and known throughout the Coastal Bend and the state of Texas for its students' academic accomplishments and extra-curricular achievements," said Dr. David Freeman. "I've had the opportunity to meet some wonderful students, parents and community members over the last few weeks and I am honored and eager for the opportunity to lead this superb district.

Dr. Freeman has been the Superintendent of Schools for London Independent School District where he served the District since 2014. In addition, he was the Superintendent of Schools in Montague ISD for five years and the Chief Academic Officer/Associate Superintendent in Wichita Falls ISD. Additionally, Dr. Freeman has been a principal, assistant principal, teacher and coach. He was an Adjunct Professor at North Central Texas College. Dr. Freeman completed his Doctorate in Education at Texas Wesleyan University. He received his master's degree from the University of North Texas and a Bachelor of Science from Midwestern State University.

Dr. Freeman is active in the community and currently serves as the Board President for the Boys' and Girls' Club of the Coastal Bend and has volunteered as a coach in a variety of youth sports organizations. He and his wife, Cassie, have three school-aged children.

The superintendent search process began in January and was led by Flour Bluff ISD Interim Superintendent, Joe Kelley. Forty-six applicants from across the nation applied for the District's top position. On May 5, the Board of Trustees voted to name Dr. Freeman as the lone finalist for the superintendent's position. State law requires the Board to wait 21 days before a contract is signed and the superintendent is officially hired.
