

STUDENT NUTRITION

In line with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Texas Education Agency (TEA) and Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA), recommendations to ensure safety for students and staff, breakfast may be either offered in the classroom and/or in the front of the schools to be consumed in the classroom upon students arrival, for Flour Bluff ISD schools for the 2020-2021 school year.

Campuses will make individual decisions on how and where lunches will be provided for students. Some campuses will elect to have lunch served in the classroom. Other campuses will stagger lunches and implement social distancing requirements for the cafeteria. Lunches may also be held in other areas of the campus, as appropriate. In addition, more lunch breaks may be added to schools as needed for students to practice social distancing appropriately.

- All staff will have their temperature check and go through a health screening each day.
- All staff will wear facial coverings and gloves during all food preparation and service.
- All staff assisting with meal distribution will wear face coverings and gloves.
- Meal delivery to classrooms will be left outside the classroom to reduce the number of staff entering the classroom space.
- Students will be required to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer prior to eating a meal.
- Students and staff will be required to maintain social distancing during meal service, this includes receiving a meal, consumption of the meal and discarding of meal leftovers.
- Food serving table or desk will need to be sanitized before, during and after each meal service.
- Students will be unable to share food therefore there will be no share table and all excess food will be thrown away.
- Food items will not be allowed to be saved for consumption at a later time.
- Students will be required to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer after eating a meal.
- At this time, due to COVID-19, mealtime visitors will not be permitted in the school cafeterias or classrooms.

Pending approval from the TDA, Flour Bluff ISD students who are taking part in remote instruction will have the option to receive breakfast and lunch meals via curbside pick-up at the Central Kitchen building. Regular meal charges will be applied to the student account therefore all students picking up meals will be required to provide student ID, report card, or

identification if parents pick up meals. Free and reduced meal program will be available for students who qualify. All ECC students will receive free breakfast and lunch meals.
