This includes reliable access to adequate technology on and off campus. As we prepare for at-home learning and possible school closures due to spikes in COVID-19, FBISD is preparing as follows:

Student Technology Resources

- Chrome books may be checked out to a student in need by the campus.
- Google Classroom will be utilized for at-home learning and for some on-campus learning.
- Online textbooks and online educational resources will be provided for instruction or to enhance instruction.
- Other online platforms will be used to engage students in high quality instruction for remote and some on-campus instruction
- Students in grades 3-12 are provided a district managed email account and Google Drive.

Teacher/Classroom Technology Resources

- Most instructional classrooms have interactive display technology installed.
- Teachers will be provided tools needed to provide at-home learning instruction (laptops/Chromebooks with cameras, software access, etc.).
- Teachers will utilize Google Classroom or Microsoft 365 to provide instruction and for students to submit assignments.
- Teachers have access to online meeting platforms to provide instruction, conduct tutoring or meet with student and/or parents.
- Teachers are provided online training resources and additional materials to enhance the digital learning environment.
