Face to Face on Campus Instruction
Procedures and Schedule beginning October 5, 2020

Face to Face on Campus Instructional Day
Monday through Friday -- 7:40 am to 3:40 pm

<p>AT HOME BEFORE SCHOOL SCREENING</p>	<p>Parents/guardians are expected to screen their students for COVID-19 symptoms each day prior to sending their students to school. We need parents' cooperation in not sending children to school who are exhibiting COVID symptoms, especially if they are running a fever.</p>
<p>ARRIVAL / DISMISSAL</p>	<p><u>ARRIVAL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Face masks are required for everyone on campus. (Face shields may be worn in addition to the face masks, not in place of the face masks.) • Drop-offs before 7:30 AM are highly discouraged. • Students who arrive before 7:30 AM will be directed to the gym. All district safety protocols will be in place. • At 7:30 AM, students will be escorted to their 1st block. • Students that arrive after 7:30 AM will go straight to 1st block. • Breakfast will be served in the classrooms. • All students will enter the building through the assigned courtyard side door. There will be school personnel to help direct students. • Parents who drop off their students will need to remain in their cars. School personnel will be in the parking lot to assist traffic flow. <p><u>DISMISSAL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be dismissed on a staggered schedule. Walkers and pick-ups will be dismissed first. • Students will exit the building through the assigned courtyard side door. • Face masks must be worn until off campus. • Upon dismissal, students will not be allowed to congregate on campus.
<p>TRANSITIONS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Movement through the building will be minimized. • Students will remain with their 1st block classroom throughout the day. • Core and elective teachers will rotate to the students. • Students will transition to P.E. and Brain Break (outside, weather permitting) by individual class. • Visual markers will assist students maintain physical distances, and adhere to established campus expectations.
<p>BREAKFAST AND LUNCH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Breakfast and lunch will be served in the classroom. • Food deliveries will not be accepted during the school day. • Visitors will not be allowed during lunch.
<p>FACE MASKS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students and staff are required to wear face masks while at school. • Face masks will cover the nose and mouth. • Face shields may be worn in addition to the face masks, not in place of the face masks.

WATER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will need to bring refillable water/sports bottles from home. Traditional water fountains will not be available. • Students will fill their water bottles at touchless water dispensers.
CLASSROOM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will not share supplies/materials. • Desks will be socially distanced. • Teachers will monitor students throughout the day and refer to the nurse if symptoms are present. • Each class will be outfitted with the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Refillable alcohol-based hand sanitizer stations. ○ Access to disinfectant to sanitize work surfaces. ○ Safety partitions for each student desk. • Teachers will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Require hand hygiene before entering and exiting the classroom and throughout the day. ○ Establish student responsibilities to clean personal areas and materials/supplies with hand sanitizer, disinfectant, and other self-cleaning products.
CAFETERIA/ELECTIVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will remain in the classroom for lunch and electives. • Students will begin to have lunch in the cafeteria as COVID-19 protocols allow. Hopefully, this will be within a few weeks. • After lunch in the cafeteria has been safely established, students will begin to attend electives as COVID-19 protocols allow.
VISITORS AND PARENT MEETINGS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents will not be allowed to walk students to class. • Campuses will utilize virtual meeting options to limit campus visitors when possible. • On campus visitors will be limited to parents by appointment. They will be required to wear face masks, sanitize their hands, and sign a campus screening document prior to entering the building.
ISOLATION PROTOCOLS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a student has displayed symptoms of COVID-19, the school nurse will provide a clinical assessment to determine if/when a student needs to be sent home and provide criteria for returning to school. • Students who are ill will be separated from their peers and should be picked up within 30 minutes and no later than 1 hour from the time the campus contacted the student's parent/guardian. • Other students will be removed from the classroom and taken to an alternate location on campus (ex. walk outside, move to a different classroom etc.) so the classroom may be disinfected.

These guidelines are for students returning to campus on October 5, 2020. Remote guidelines will be distributed separately.
