Modified Operations



Positive COVID-19 results are taken very seriously and are investigated individually. Prior to moving to the remote/virtual learning or hybrid learning platform, campus and district administrators will consult with nurses, review guidance from state and local health officials and analyze the positivity rate to make the safest decisions for our district staff, students and community.

- Students and staff in impacted area(s) move to remote/virtual learning model.
 - Affected area is closed for deep cleaning.
 - High School campus will move to hybrid or virtual learning platform.

Facility Closure

Confirmed, active COVID-19 cases exceeds 10% of facility occupancy

- Entire facility will be closed to sanitize.
 - All activities cancelled.
 - All students and staff move to remote learning model.

District Closure

Confirmed, active COVID-19 cases exceeds 10% of the District in multiple facilities OR direction received from city, county, state or national executive orders

- All FBISD facilities close.
- Students and staff move to remote learning model.
- All auxiliary areas such as playgrounds and athletic facilities closed.
- Extracurricular activities are cancelled.
- All UIL events will follow UIL guidelines.
