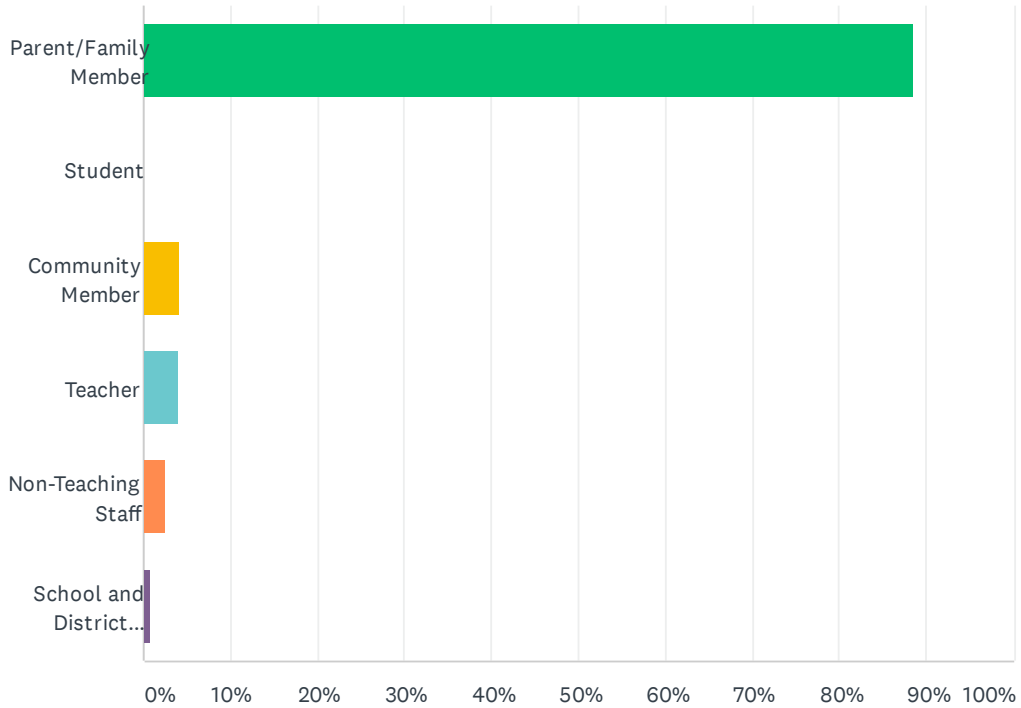


Q1 Are you a:

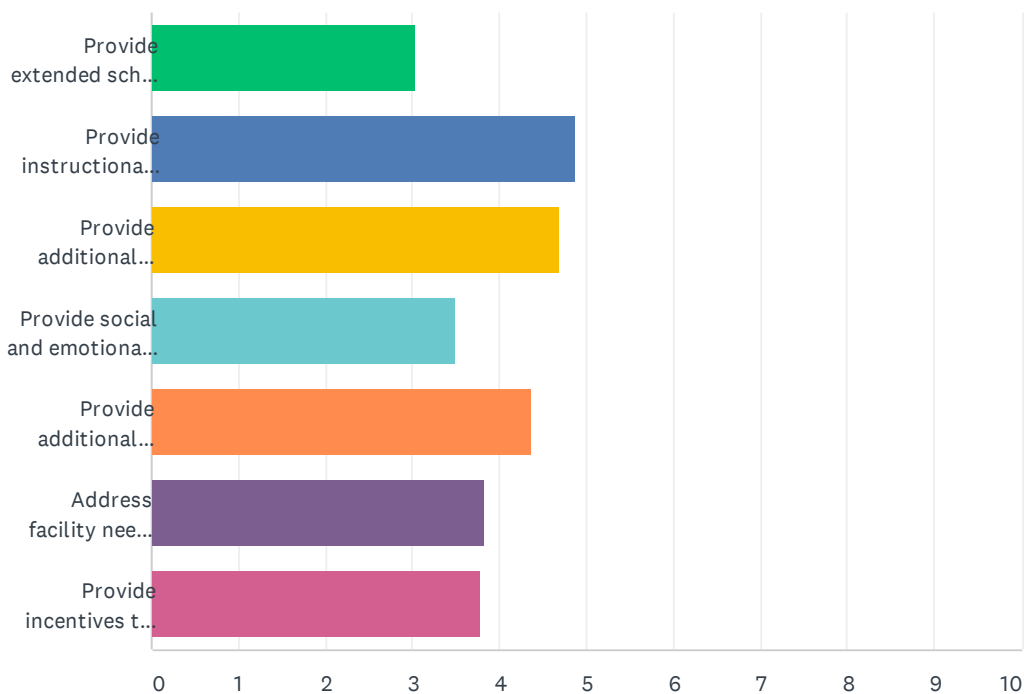
