




MARINES VISIT SUPERINTENDENT SOLIZ-GARCIA

HORNET FOOTBALL TICKETS

We look forward to another great year of Hornet Football! Below is information regarding football tickets for the 2021 season. Due to unforeseen circumstances, we will sell only General Admission tickets for all home games for the 2021 football season. All ticket sales will be sold



<u>online</u> and redeemed at the gate. We will not sell tickets at the ticket booth. Tickets can be purchased sold <u>online at our PayK12 Store</u>.

FOOTBALL TICKETS - VARSITY HOME GAMES:

The district will sell general admission tickets weekly <u>at our online PayK12 Store</u>. We are not offering season tickets for general admission.

- Tickets will go on sale at 12 a.m. (Midnight) on the Monday of a home game and continue through Game Day of that week.
- There will be a limit of 8 tickets per transaction.
- Prices are \$6.00 for students, \$7.00 for adults, and \$8.00 on game day.
- Children 3 years of age and older will need a ticket to enter the stadium.
- Children under 3 will have to sit in their parent's lap.

If you were a season ticket holder for the 2019 Football Season, you will continue to be recognized as a season ticket holder for the 2022 football season if you choose to purchase your tickets. The district will share more information during the spring semester.

FOOTBALL TICKETS - JUNIOR HIGH AND SUB-VARSITY HOME GAMES:

All tickets for Junior High and Sub-Varsity will be sold online at our PayK12 Store.

- There is no limit on the number of tickets you may purchase.
- Tickets will go on sale the day before the game.
- Children 3 years of age and older will need a ticket to enter the stadium.
- Children under 3 will have to sit in their parent's lap.

UPDATE FROM FBISD PD


The FBISD PD is reminding any to first call "DISPATCH" when police assistance is needed, rather than an individual's cell phone. This will help create a faster response time.

911 should be called for urgent medical concerns. This allows a quicker response from EMS. A follow-up call to FBISD PD can be made following the call to 911.

COVID-19 UPDATE

For the 2021-2022 school year, staff and students will continue to follow all protocols for COVID-19 at campus and district facilities. To view the District's 2021-2022 Student & Staff Safety Protocols, click here.

The testing clinic has been testing students and staff each day. This week, the Clinic has tested approximately 200 individuals. The Clinic allows students and staff exhibiting symptoms to complete a rapid test



on-site and free of charge. The COVID-19 Testing Clinic is located in a classroom past the Print Shop and Spirit Shop and is open from 8 a.m. - 12 p.m. (Noon) each school day.

Intermediate - 28 students; 1 staff member

Elementary - 24 students; 3 staff members

Primary - 10 students; 0 staff members

ECC - 12 students; 3 staff members

District - 4 staff
