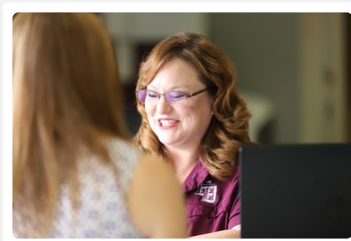
"I'm looking forward to a great year," said Don Youngberg. "I'm very excited about the direction the District is going."

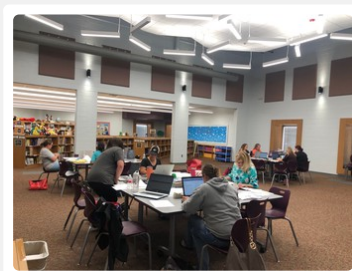

SUMMER SCHOOL UPDATE

Flour Bluff ISD Summer School program is designed to offer accelerated instruction for students who have fallen behind, lost credit, or wish to advance in the instruction. Students will have the opportunity to reinforce and strengthen skills for the next grade level throughout the Summer School Program.

EMPLOYEE BENEFITS UPDATE

The District is looking into Picwell as a tool to help our employees select the right health care coverage plan. This week, a group of employees from Athletics, Central Office and Maintenance took part in a demo of the tool. If the district decides to move forward with Picwell, this will aid employees in selecting the best health care plan option during open enrollment.



The estimated cost for Picwell is \$10,000 and will be reimbursed by Aetna resulting in no additional cost to the district.

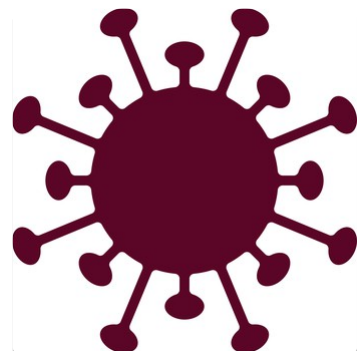


COVID-19 UPDATE AND ONLINE TRACKER
