# TEACHER INCENTIVE ALLOTMENT UPDATE

Three district teachers have received a designation through the Texas Education Agency (TEA) Texas Teacher Incentive Program. House Bill 3 (HB 3), passed by the 86th Texas Legislature in June of 2019, established an optional Teacher Incentive Allotment with a stated goal of a six-figure salary for teachers who prioritize teaching in high needs areas and rural district campuses.



Together, these FBISD teachers have generated \$13,114. Ninety percent of that money will go back to the teachers as an incentive through the program. Additionally, each teacher will have a designation placed on their teaching certificate.

In the near future, we will invite each of the teachers to be recognized during an upcoming board meeting. At that time, we will have the opportunity to celebrate each of them and they will officially receive their Teacher Incentive Allotment.

## CALENDAR COMMITTEE MEETING UPDATE

The District Calendar Committee met on June 16, 2021 at 4:15 p.m. via zoom to initiate a discussion for the 2022-2023 school calendar. At the meeting, roles, responsibilities, and expectations were reviewed. In addition, we had Ludivina Cansino, Chief Financial Officer, present information on fiscal year start date and the importance of the alignment of this date with an intercessional calendar. Lastly, we shared with the committee items to keep in mind as we move forward in the fall and begin the process of adopting the 2022-2023 calendar.

Next Budget Workshop will be held in a couple of weeks. We'll provide that information once a firm date has been set.




