CO-OP Program Awards More Than \$2 Million in Grants to Texas Communities, including FBISD


Community Outdoor Outreach Program (CO-OP) recently announced the winners of their grant awards totaling over **2 million dollars**. Flour Bluff ISD's very own Ocean's Program has been awarded **\$59,389.00**!

The Oceans Program increases existing wetland education programs to provide more students with experiential, TEKS-based environmental science lessons and recreational activities such as kayaking, fishing, and bird watching. TPWD's Aquatic Science curriculum is used to create a water quality monitoring program on the district's wetland sites and field trips to TPWD's Marine Center and Redhead Wildlife Management Area.

CO-OP grant recipients include churches, conservation groups, nature centers, non-profit organizations, school districts, and municipalities. Funded projects range from physical education classes focused on mountain biking at Franklin Mountains State Park to wheelchair-adapted vessels on the Laguna Madre Bay and Spanish language programs educating residents about the health of creeks and streams.

From all of us here at Flour Bluff ISD, we are elated and so very proud of the hard work and dedication put forth by our Ocean's Committee that continues to pave the way for our Hornets.

We want to thank our educators who worked so hard to make this week special and engaging to our students!

































Elementary Fun Run brings some fun in the sun as we finish Texas Public Schools Week!



Integrated Oceans Program announces Grant Award and Spotlights Stephanie Huckabee!

In November, the Integrated Oceans Committee, comprised of Flour Bluff ISD staff and community members, submitted a grant through The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department's (TPWD) Community Outdoor Outreach Program (CO-OP). This past week, the FBISD Oceans Committee received word the proposed project was fully funded at \$59,389!

The Oceans Program project will increase existing wetland education programs to provide more students with experiential, TEKS-based environmental science lessons and recreational activities such as kayaking, fishing, and bird watching. The Integrated Oceans Program will use TPWD's Aquatic Science curriculum to create a water quality monitoring program on the district's wetland sites and support field trips to TPWD's Marine Center and Redhead Wildlife Management Area. Special thanks to our FBISD teachers- Stephanie Huckabee, Steven Dial, Katie Doyle, Marisa Flores, FBISD Curriculum Supervisor- Jennifer Norman, TAMUCC Community Partners- Dr. Larissa Ford, and Dr. Dorina Murgulet, for their knowledge, time, and effort in writing this grant! Congratulations to the Oceans Committee!

Additionally, the Intermediate Oceans Program has been awarded another grant! This grant will expand the partnership between the Flour Bluff Intermediate Oceans Program and the Texas A & M-Corpus Christi Whale and Dolphins Program. At the end of the grant, FB Intermediate should have a doctoral thesis written on fostering a school-university relationship.

Furthermore, the Aquatic Science class at the High School completed day one of their trip to Texas A&M's Floating classroom. The course is led by Stephanie Huckabee, who has taught in Flour Bluff ISD for 10+ years. Ms. Huckabee serves on the district's Integrated Oceans Committee and plays an


partnerships with the community to improve the Aquatic Science class at Flour Bluff High School. Her expertise has been instrumental in making our Oceans program a success.

Ms. Huckabee secured a grant through Texas A&M College Station funded through the EPA and NOAA on Ocean Acidification. Students participated in several demonstrations that showed the importance of studying and finding ways to combat ocean acidification. Students then got to contribute data to the EPA/NOAA studies on how it affects the local bays and estuaries with various tests. Besides collecting pH, temperature, turbidity, salinity, and a few other water parameters, students collected plankton and recorded the variety of animal life accumulated in the trawl nets.

Earlier this week, Ocean Student Ambassador members had a great time planting seeds at the Redhead Pond Wildlife Area. Thank you for doing such a fantastic job helping cultivate and preserve our environment.


