




In her 11th year of teaching, Intermediate teacher Sophie Ruefle makes learning interactive and inspires her students!

Way to go, Hornets! We are so proud of all of you!




Meeting our goal of reaching 1:1 devices for our Hornets!




Workforce Solutions visits SDGC students for an unforgettable virtual experience for their future!

Integrated Oceans Program update


