At the recent TMSCA State Championship, the Flour Bluff Intermediate and Junior High Math/Science Team continued their rich history of success

On April 2nd, the Flour Bluff Junior High and Intermediate Math/Science Team traveled to San Antonio for the TMSCA State Championship and won for the 37th consecutive year. From information gathered, Flour Bluff won their first TMSCA Championship in 1985, and our fabulous Hornets have been winning the state champion every year since.

Our Hornets won the Team championship by almost 900 points winning Team Number Sense, Calculator, and Science and 2nd in General Math by 3 points. They were the individual state champion in 8 out of 12 events, winning 48 out of a possible 90 top 10 individual events in math and 10 out of 30 top ten individual events in science. The 8th grade Hornets had 3 of the most challenging years dealing with Covid. Even when no one knew what would happen, our Hornets continued to work and led this team through difficult times.

A huge thank you to all of our Paraprofessionals! Thank you all for Inspiring, Fostering, and Empowering!














We are buzzing about our Assistant Principals this week! Thanks for all you do, Assistant Principals!

Spirit Week dates will include the following:


April 11th: Proud to be an American. Wear Red, White and Blue day.




