FLOUR BLUFF INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE SUPERINTENDENT OR DESIGNEE TO UTILIZE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING COOPERATIVES AND EXECUTE AN ELECTRICITY CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Flour Bluff Independent School District ("District") seeks to protect the District's financial resources and secure competitive electricity pricing; and

WHEREAS, the District's current electricity contract will expire in May 2026, creating the need to proactively plan for future electricity procurement; and

WHEREAS, interlocal purchasing cooperatives provide school districts with the advantage of leveraging collective purchasing power to obtain more favorable rates and contract terms; and


WHEREAS, authorizing the Superintendent or designee to utilize interlocal purchasing cooperatives and execute an electricity contract in advance ensures the District is positioned to monitor market conditions, act swiftly, and protect against potential price increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Flour Bluff Independent School District hereby authorizes the Superintendent or designee to:

1. Utilize interlocal purchasing cooperatives for the procurement of electricity services;
2. Negotiate and execute an electricity contract on behalf of the District for a term of up to **120 months** and at a rate not to exceed **\$0.0700 per kWh**; and
3. Take any other actions necessary to ensure the District secures competitive electricity pricing in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.




