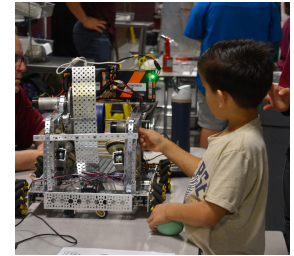
4 Intermediate STEAM Night Sparks Curiosity & Fun
